Guidelines for the Consideration of BC United Soccer Association Scholarship Application

BC United Soccer Association process will work as follows:

1. BC United Soccer Association reserves the right to update the application form to conform to the calendar year and any other changes that might be necessary.
2. The BC United Soccer Association Scholarship will be an annual one-time award of \$500 to each of two high school seniors (one girl and one boy).
3. Any and all high school seniors who will meet the criteria listed in the Scholarship Application shall be eligible to receive a scholarship award.
4. Each year the BC United Soccer Association Board will appoint a committee to review the applications and make decisions that they will then present to the BC United Soccer Association Board.
5. The applications will be considered on the merit of the information presented in the application form alone without consideration of any other factors.
6. Any BC United Soccer Association Board member whose child has submitted an application shall exclude oneself from any scholarship application review process.
7. The results of the BC United Soccer Association Scholarship process will be kept confidential until the appropriate High School Department schedules an announcement date. This is to ensure that the recipients of the scholarship(s) are announced at the appropriate time and place with other scholarships.
8. The management and the disbursement of the funds will be the responsibility of the BC United Soccer Association Treasurer. The recipient shall collect the check at BC United Soccer Association's August Board meeting.
